1. Lent and Easter Season

- Environmental is meeting on Saturday to decorate for Palm Sunday, with a reset planned for Saturday 4-15 for Easter Sunday.
- Two times the prior amount of flowers ordered to fill the church and worship spaces. Some of the flowers will be used for Holy Thursday.
- Two additional men required to carry the cross at 3:00 on Good Friday
- Holy Thursday no procession of the altar cloth as it is covered – need to assure stands are available for oils



Lenten observations to date noted for next year planning:

- Keep the traditional Lenten Sunday morning entrance procession
- Ash Wednesday: locate the table holding ashes to the top of the stairs in front of the altar; keep the table there the entire Mass -- no need to move it.

2. Masses aligned with Faith Formation

- Planning adjustments to the Mass schedule to include Mass as an integral component of future Faith Formation classes
- Mass focus with youth in mind and participation / roles in assisting with the service
- Parent attendance encouraged
