

Code of Conduct

2017 Summer Stretch – Church of Saint John Neumann

- 1) Stay at the event or site at all times.
Remain with the SJN group, and participate in all event activities.
- 2) Respect church, event/recreation site and transportation property.
Anyone who causes damage will pay for it.
- 3) Respect the leadership staff and other groups or individuals using the event or recreation site.
Stay out of the working, meeting of any other groups or individuals.
- 4) Submit all medications, prescription or otherwise, to an adult team member.
Adult team members maintain and monitor all medications.
- 5) Do not bring alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, and/or tobacco in any form.
If you are under the influence of or in possession of any controlled substance, parents and/or police will be called.
- 6) Do not bring electronic entertainment (iPod, mp3/cd/radio, etc.), or Cell phones.
If brought to Summer Stretch, it will be taken by the leadership staff until the day is over.
- 7) Do not act exclusively as a couple or engage in any intimate or sexual activity.
- 8) Use appropriate language – and appropriate volume levels.
- 9) Wear appropriate clothing for:
 - a. a Catholic event (modest, not revealing) and
 - b. the weather conditions.
- 10) Accept and follow direction from the leadership team and the event/site staff.
- 11) Have fun!

If, at any time, you are uncomfortable with a person on the event (whether participant or team member) or any component of the event itself, or if you cannot participate in an activity, please speak any SJN staff member who is present. We want this to be a fun, safe, and meaningful weekend for you and for everyone.

SJN staff reserve the right to modify and/or add rules at any time.

Violating this Code of Conduct will result in a discussion with team leadership and the possibility of a phone call home; it may also result in removal from the event and transportation home at parent/guardian expense.
