LENTEN PRACTICES

- PRAYER:** All are encouraged to find more opportunities to pray, study, and celebrate the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist.
- ALMSGIVING:** Lenten almsgiving binds us closer to the suffering members of the Body of Christ. Alms box is near the cross in the gathering space. Donations support the Catholic Campaign for Human Development.
- FASTING:** Fasting draws us into solidarity with the sacrifice of Christ and invites us to turn to God who alone can truly satisfy our desires.
- Days of Abstinence - On Ash Wednesday and ALL Fridays in Lent, those 14 and older may not eat meat.
 - Days of Fast - On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, those ages 18 through 59 may eat only one full, meatless meal, plus two smaller meatless meals with no solid food between meals.
